Mandatory Account Codes

- Code lengths are four digits and are not validated so that any four-digit code can be entered
- Available for Dedicated and Switched service

Mandatory Reserved Account Codes

- Code lengths are five digits and must be entered before the call will be completed
- ACC Business or customers can select the codes, which must be reserved in advance of use
- Available for Dedicated and Switched customers with minimum monthly usage of \$5,000
- Prior to submitting the order for Mandatory Reserved Account codes on switched or dedicated voice services an ICB (Individual Case Basis), which includes the list of requested codes is required

Outbound Long Distance Dedicated Voice Service

- Dedicated 12 and 24 and 36-Month Interstate Service Plans
- Interstate rates are cents per minute (CPM)
